DESCRIPTION:

Microcrystalline cellulose is purified, isolated colloidal crystalline cellulose derived from fibrous plants. It is porous and can carry a high load of both aqueous and oily products while exhibiting exceptional compressibility. It may be used in conjunction with Actiphyte[®] or Aromaphytes[®]. Acticel may also be used as an exfoliating scrub due to the unique size and shape of the microcrystallines.

Acticel[®] 12 is recommended to enhance the texture and application of soaps, pressed and loose powders, and scrubs.
